## HISTORY

We will be finding out about Neil Armstrong, the Moon landings and the development of space travel. We will also be making comparisons to British astronaut Tim Peake and finding out about his achievements.

## Science


The children will be exploring which part of the body is associated with which sense as well as distinguishing between an object and the material with which it is made. We will describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials.

## RE

Our students will be learning about what Christians believe about God, his role in their lives and his significance to the faith. We will be thinking about how God can be represented, such as a leader and a Father.

## PE

In completing their Fundamentals unit, pupils will explore the fundamental skills of balancing, running, changing direction, jumping, hopping and skipping. Pupils will also work on their ball skills, focusing on their throwing and catching abilities.



## ART AND DT

In Art, students will explore observational drawing and experimental mark making, and think about how they can use spirals within their own pieces. In DT, children will learn about how sliders and levers are constructed and used.



## COMPUTING AND MUSIC

Pupils will be concentrating on being able to log on to the computers consistently, as well as identifying the use of computers in their daily lives. In Music, they will be listening for and replicating the beat and pulse of a piece.
