WHAT WAS THEIR IMPACT AND HOW DID THEY MAKE CHANGES STILL RELEVANT IN 2024?





HISTORY

In studying some of the significant changes brought about by the Victorians, we will be exploring their impact and legacy on industry, education and medicine. We will explore Queen Victoria's family tree and the reach of her power across the world.

Science

Year 5 will be studying forces, their uses and the ways in which we can investigate the effects of gravity and upthrust.

Year 6 will be examining how we maintain healthy bodies through an in-depth study of the circulatory system.

RE

Our students will be learning about the religion of Judaism and some of the key figures linked to the topic, such as Moses. We will consider the role of the Ten Commandments and how these are evidenced in daily Jewish practices and celebrations.

PΕ

Children will revisit the game of Dodgeball and will learn how to set up a series of moves to score, as well as developing their reaction times and short, accurate movements. In Badminton, students will perfect their overhead and serving shots.





ART AND COMPUTING

We will be looking at how we can create typography through drawing and design, and use our skills to create personal and highly visual maps. In Computing, students will be finding out how technology plays a vital role in different forms of communication.



FRENCH AND MUSIC

Pupils will be recapping previous vocabulary to describe ourselves, as well as learning the names of a range of school supplies to recall a day in the classroom. In Music, we will be identifying melodic phrases in different pieces of music.
