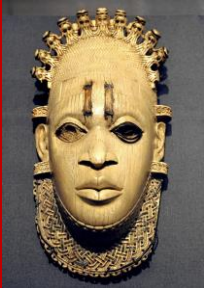


Ancient Benin

WHO WERE THIS GROUP OF PEOPLE AND HOW DIFFERENT WERE THEY TO MEDIEVAL BRITAIN?



HISTORY

Using the themes of leadership and beliefs, our pupils will complete a detailed comparison between life in Benin (West Africa) and Medieval Britain, contrasting their views on rulers, expansion and trade.

Science

Year 5 will be deepening their understanding of space exploration and assessing how and why key theories about the Solar System have changed over time.

Year 6 will be using fossil evidence to investigate evolution and consider which traits living things inherit.

RE

We will be considering the ways in which different religions show their care and respect for the environment. We will look at the work of organisations who are tasked with caring for the natural world, such as Christian Aid and the WWF.

PE

Children will be developing their dribbling, defending and scoring accuracy as we look at team games such as Football. In Dance, pupils will work in pairs and groups to join together motifs to create a longer sequence of moves that can be performed for others.



DT AND COMPUTING

We will be designing, modifying and sewing our own felt phone cases after completing market research into our product. In Computing, we will continue to develop our knowledge of Scratch and use our programming skills to create more complex routines.



FRENCH AND MUSIC

The children will be learning the names for a variety of sports in French and will be able to explain which ones they like or dislike using the verb 'jouer'. In Music, we will be studying the genre of the Pop Ballad.
