





Activity	Where will I find the resources?
	<p>Follow Duggee's instructions for brushing your teeth. Show your adult your groovy dance moves to the music!</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=oStaJTHgHMU</p>
	<p>Go on a sound walk. Listen to all the sounds you can hear on your walk. Remember that you need to be really quiet when you listen so you can hear even the quietest of sounds. You could take photos or draw pictures of anything you hear. These can be uploaded onto SeeSaw so we can talk about them when we return to Nursery.</p>
	<p>Our Book of the Week this week is a story called Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers. The little boy in the story needs to make a journey - we've been talking a lot about journeys at Nursery recently. Share this story together at home using the link - would you like to go on a journey with the boy and the penguin? 	<p>We are learning about prepositions in our Maths sessions - it sounds complicated but they are words that mean where something is. Our key words are: on/on top under beside/next to in between. You can practise these words with lots of things at home - a teddy and a chair would do. There are 3 different ways to practise these words:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ask your child to put the teddy beside the chair (for example) - this practises understanding. 2. Ask your child to describe where the teddy is (eg the teddy is under the chair) - this practises use of language. 3. Make a mistake (eg tell your child the teddy is under the chair when it is beside the chair) - this allows your child to reason and correct your mistakes.
