HISTORY

During this topic, students will be studying one of the earliest civilizations, Ancient Egypt. They will consider how historians have gathered evidence after thousands of years, as well as exploring the role of the Pharaoh and the Gods.

Science

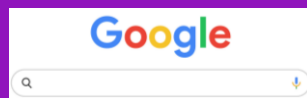
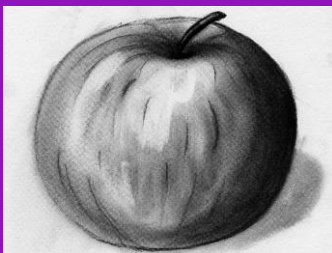
The children will be able to name different types of rock and give the physical features of each. They will explore how a fossil is formed and explain how soils are made from rocks, debris as well as living/dead matter.

RE

Our students will be finding out about the Hindu festival of light, Diwali. As well as learning the story behind the celebration, students will consider the importance of light within different religious practices.

PE

As always, one class will be attending swimming sessions each week as part of our PE curriculum. In our other sessions, children will be developing their ball skills through the game of Dodgeball, thinking about how quick reaction times support short, accurate movements.



ART AND COMPUTING

Children will explore how charcoal can be used to make loose, gestural movements as they build upon their previous sketching skills. In Computing, we will be learning about how to use the Internet safely as a source of information, as well as selecting key words when using a range of search engines.



FRENCH AND MUSIC

Pupils will be recapping numbers up to 10 in French, as well as building their confidence in discussing school and items you would need to learn. In Music, we will be studying time signatures and how music can link ideas together.
