Mathematics This half term we will be: - Making sure we count one object at a time saying one number at a time when counting larger amounts. - Comparing groups of different amounts. - Using 5 frames for subitising and counting.	Literacy This half term we will be: - Recall and talk about our different favourite stories. - Thinking and talking about the characters in each story and the setting that they take place in. - Enjoy writing for different purposes eg letters, shopping lists, calling a register.	Physical Development This half term we will be: - Noticing that we have a dominant hand or foot. - Practising manipulating tools and resources by investigating the objects we use. - Becoming aware of what our bodies need physically in the hot weather. - Keeping our bodies safe in the sun and around water.
Personal, Social and Emotional Development This half term we will be: - Be able to ask for help from an adult or a peer in new or challenging experiences. - Showing confidence in choosing activities and resources for a purpose. - Persevering with an activity when it gets challenging.	Understanding the World This half term we will be: - Talking about why the weather is changing and getting warmer. - Thinking about how we can look after living things in our environment. - Learning about how to keep safe around water. - Thinking about how we can help save water at Nursery and at home.	Expressive Arts and Design This half term we will be: - Using a combination of lines, curves and circles to draw. - Creating large scale art outdoors using gross motor skills. - We will look at the art work of Kandinsky to inspire our own artwork. - Acting out our favourite stories in the role play area.
